| Prize Conditions: | (i) The winner must be present at the MACA 200 Ride, and must have their proof of registration (“ Proof of Purchase ”), when the Prize winner is drawn on 26 October 2019, to collect the Prize. In the event the re-draw winner is not present to claim the Prize, the Promoter reserves the right to re-draw the Prize, at each five (5) minute interval until a winner is confirmed, or to cancel the Prize. Promotion Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter, and other details and information contained within the Promotion schedule, form part of these Terms and Conditions. By participating in the Promotion entrants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
2. The Promoter's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
3. No part of the Prize can be used in conjunction with any other discounts or special offers.
4. The winner must not use any part of the Prize in conjunction with any commercial or other promotional activity. No part of the Prize may be on-sold by the winner.
5. If for any reason the Prize, or any element of the Prize, is not capable of being redeemed because of any cause beyond the control of the Promoter, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion and/or the Prize.
6. No entry fee is charged by the Promoter to enter the Promotion.
7. The terms and conditions which apply to use of the Prize, including the Conditions of Entry to the Venue and the ticketing agent terms and conditions, at the time it is redeemed and used by the Winner will prevail over these Terms and Conditions, to the extent of any inconsistency.
8. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions restricts, excludes or modifies or purports to restrict, exclude or modify any statutory consumer rights under any applicable law including the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth).
9. If for any reason any aspect of this Promotion is not capable of running as planned, including by reason of computer virus, communications network failure, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any cause beyond the control of the Promoter, the Promoter may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion and invalidate any affected entries, or suspend or modify the Prize.
10. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to validate and check the authenticity of entries and entrant's details (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence). In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof as required by the Promoter to validate their entry, the winner will forfeit the Prize in whole and no substitute will be offered. Incomplete, indecipherable, inaudible, incorrect and illegible entries, as applicable, will at the Promoter's discretion be deemed invalid and not eligible to win. Entries containing offensive or defamatory comments, or which breach any law or infringe any third party rights, including intellectual property rights, are not eligible to win. The use of any automated entry software or any other mechanical or electronic means that allows an individual to automatically enter repeatedly is prohibited and may render all entries submitted by that individual invalid.
11. Neither the Promoter nor the Venue, nor any of their respective employees, contractors, associated agencies and companies, nor any supplier, provider or other third-party associated with the Promotion or any element of the Prize will be liable for any loss (including, without limitation, indirect, special or consequential loss or loss of profits), expense, damage, personal injury or death which is suffered or sustained (whether or not arising from any person's negligence or willful misconduct) in connection with this Promotion or accepting or using any element of the Prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law (in which case that liability is limited to the minimum allowable by law).
12. It is a condition of accepting any element of the Prize that the winner and his/her guest consent to the use of their name and image for promotional purposes associated with the Promotion, and participate in and co-operate as required with all reasonable marketing and editorial activities relating to the Promotion, including (but not limited to) being recorded, photographed, filmed or interviewed and acknowledges that the Promoter and the Venue may use any such marketing and editorial material without further reference or compensation to them.

13. The Promoter collects personal information for the purposes of processing and administering entries to the Promotion, and provision of the Prize. By providing their personal information entrants agree to the terms of the Promoter's privacy policy. The Promoter may also pass personal information of all entrants to the Venue, where the Venue requires such information to provide any element of the Prize, or otherwise fulfil any requirement of the Promotion. The Venue may similarly pass personal information of the winner to any other third parties associated with the Promotion and/or any element of the Prize, and will otherwise handle all personal information in accordance with the Venue's Privacy Policy, which can be found at <https://optusstadium.com.au/privacy-policy/>. The aforementioned privacy policies of each of the Promoter and Venue (collectively the "Collectors") contains information about how the entrant may access, update and seek correction of the personal information the respective Collector holds about them and how the entrant may complain about any potential breach by the respective Collector of the Australian Privacy Principles or any other Australian privacy laws and how such complaints will be dealt with.
14. Each of the Collectors may use entrants' personal information for research and profiling purposes as well as other purposes reasonably related to the entrants' relationship with them. In addition, by entering the Promotion, entrants' consent to the Collectors and suppliers, providers or other third- parties associated with the Promotion or any element of the Prize, using their personal information for the purpose of sending information regarding programs, products and services available through them. The Collectors will each provide entrants with the ability to opt out of those communications. The Collectors may also disclose the entrants' personal information to the State and lottery departments, if required under the applicable State lottery legislation. If the entrant does not provide their personal information as requested, they may be ineligible to enter the Promotion. The Promoter may transfer entrants' personal information to countries specified in the Promoter's privacy policy. The Venue will not disclose entrants' personal information overseas.
