

# PERTH STADIUM – CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## 2019-20 CRICKET SEASON

The following Conditions of Entry apply to all patrons (**Patrons** or **Ticket Holders**) attending events or functions at Perth Stadium.

These Conditions of Entry are to be read in conjunction with conditions of entry that may apply to (i) a particular event (**Event Conditions**, refer to the event page at [www.Perthstadium.com.au](http://www.Perthstadium.com.au)); (ii) the ticketing agent's terms and conditions of ticket sale (**Ticket Conditions**, refer to [www.ticketmaster.com.au/h/purchase.html](http://www.ticketmaster.com.au/h/purchase.html)); and/or (iii) specific conditions of sports governing bodies (**Specific Conditions**). Each of these conditions may include additional terms to those set out in these Conditions of Entry.

Specific Conditions of entry will apply from the website of the respective sports governing bodies:

- Cricket Australia - Ticket & Entry Conditions, National Refund Policy, Policy Statement on Inappropriate Conduct

Patrons or Ticket Holders who fail to comply with the Conditions of Entry, Event Conditions, Ticket Conditions and/or Specific Conditions will be refused entry to Perth Stadium. Patrons or Ticket Holders who have been admitted but subsequently refuse to comply with the Conditions of Entry, Event Conditions, Ticket Conditions and/or Specific Conditions (as applicable) may be removed from Perth Stadium without refund or compensation of any kind under any circumstances.

Perth Stadium reserves the right to update, modify or change these Conditions of Entry from time to time. Any changes will be posted and available at [www.Perthstadium.com.au](http://www.Perthstadium.com.au) and may be available at entry points to Perth Stadium. The Event Conditions, Ticket Conditions or Special Conditions may be updated, modified or changed by the event owner, ticketing agent or sports governing bodies, at the said parties discretion and any such changes will be posted and available at the applicable website.

### Refusal of Entry

Perth Stadium reserves the right to refuse entry to any:

- Patron or Ticket Holder it deems to be intoxicated, drug affected, disorderly, threatening or abusive;
- unauthorised Patron or Ticket Holder;
- Patron or Ticket Holder carrying items which have the potential to compromise safety, or cause injury or public nuisance;
- Patron or Ticket Holder not holding a valid ticket, including tickets purchased from an unauthorised source, from a ticket scalper, or which appears to have been defaced, forged or copied;
- Patron or Ticket Holder who refuses to be checked or submit its belongings for inspection; or
- vehicle where a Patron or Ticket Holder refuses to comply with the vehicle security check process.

### General Conditions

- Perth Stadium reserves the right to inspect and search bags, regardless of size, of all Patrons and Ticket Holders who enter or exit Perth Stadium. This may include touching the outside of the bag and / or seeking assistance of the bag owner to remove items from the bag.
- Perth Stadium reserves the right to conduct personal checks of all Patrons and Ticket Holders who enter or exit Perth Stadium. This may include pat down searches and/or wandings.
- Patrons and Ticket Holders must not attempt to conceal their identity, either at the point of entry or while inside Perth Stadium. Perth Stadium will respect cultural differences and medical conditions, but reserves the right to refuse entry to, or remove from, Perth Stadium anyone who covers their face with a scarf, balaclava, mask, helmet, etc.
- The wearing of any 'colours' or 'insignia' signifying belonging to any outlaw motorcycle club (OMC) or other group as designated by Police, is prohibited. This includes coats, T-shirts, waistcoats, caps, patches etc. that indicate a Patron or Ticket Holder belongs to any OMC or other prohibited group.
- Patrons and Ticket Holders wearing or otherwise displaying inappropriate or unauthorised commercial, political, religious or other offensive images, logos, messages etc. may be denied entry into Perth Stadium or asked to remove such items prior to entering Perth Stadium.
- Patrons and Ticket Holders gaining unauthorised access to Perth Stadium and/or the pitch/playing field may be evicted from Perth Stadium and may be subject to penalties, including imprisonment and fines.
- Patrons and Ticket Holders who become intoxicated, drug affected, disorderly, threatening or abusive, cause a disturbance, or refuse to comply with any direction, request or announcements made by Stadium staff, will be evicted from Perth Stadium.
- Pass-outs for re-entry to Perth Stadium will not be issued.
- Patrons and Ticket Holders must occupy the seat specified on their ticket.
- Unless otherwise specified, children 12 years and under will not be admitted without a parent or guardian (16 years or older), and must remain with them at all times. Patrons and Ticket Holders must comply with any age specifications or restrictions detailed on the ticket.
- Smoking is not permitted within the main Perth Stadium building and Patrons and Ticket Holders must utilise the smoking areas adjacent to Perth Stadium entry points. Patrons and Ticket Holders who smoke, other than in the designated smoking areas, commit an offence and may be subject to penalties, including fines.
- Patrons and Ticket Holders wishing to bring permitted items into Perth Stadium do so at their own risk. Perth Stadium will not be held responsible for any damage to, loss or theft of a Patron or Ticket Holder's personal property.
- Umbrellas may be brought into Perth Stadium but for the comfort of others should not be put up.
- For safety reasons, strollers and prams are not permitted in Perth Stadium seating bowl. Strollers and prams may be stored in cloakrooms provided adjacent to the entry gates.
- Unauthorised soliciting and customer surveying is not permitted within Perth Stadium.
- Patrons and Ticket Holders are not permitted to throw any objects around or within Perth Stadium. Patrons and Ticket Holders identified as throwing objects will be evicted from Perth Stadium.
- Some sporting and other activities conducted at sporting and entertainment venues are dangerous. Risks include collision with fixed or moving objects, falling or tripping, exposure to adverse weather, or acts of violence committed by other Patrons or Ticket Holders. All Patrons and Ticket Holders attending events and functions at Perth Stadium do so at their own risk. Perth Stadium is not responsible or liable for any loss, damage, accident or injury suffered by any Patron or Ticket Holder, including that of any children under their care.

- Tickets to events at Perth Stadium or the Stadium Park may not be used in relation to any unauthorised promotion or competition. Promotional or commercial activities within Perth Stadium or the Stadium Park, in relation to an event or function or otherwise, are not permitted. Patrons and Ticket Holders who conduct any unauthorised activities will be required to immediately cease such activities and may be evicted from Perth Stadium and the Stadium Park. Patrons and Ticket Holders holding tickets sourced through unauthorised promotional or commercial activities may be denied access to Perth Stadium.
- Perth Stadium may photograph and record event crowds from time to time, and may use these photographs and recordings for any media or other purpose, including advertising or promotional purposes, without payment of any kind to Patrons and Ticket Holders.
- Patrons and Ticket Holders are advised that strobe lighting may be utilised for events at Perth Stadium.
- For the safety and security of Patrons and Ticket Holders and other Stadium occupants closed circuit television cameras are in use at this Stadium. Photographs and recordings of Patrons and Ticket Holders may be shared with the police and other authorities.

### **Restricted / Prohibited Items**

Patrons and Ticket Holders are not permitted to bring the following restricted / prohibited items into Perth Stadium:

- Glassware, glass bottles or cans, including spray cans.
- Opened or unsealed drink bottles including water and soft drink bottles.
- Cold liquids in thermoses and flasks (hot liquids in thermoses are permitted)
- Alcoholic beverages.
- Illegal substances, including illegal drugs.
- Flares, fireworks, weapons, explosives or smoke bombs.
- Laser pointers.
- Knives or other dangerous weapons.
- Pets or animals, other than assistance dogs.
- Folding chairs or stools.
- Cameras and or recording devices (for commercial purposes) including tripods. Personal photography is permitted, provided photographs are for non-commercial use.
- Remote control vehicles, including drones (or any such aircraft).
- Metal flag poles, extendable flag poles and / or flag poles of more than 1.6 metres in length.
- Oversized banners and flags which are deemed to cause public nuisance. Specific conditions may apply for some events regarding the entry of flagpoles, flags, and banners.
- Musical instruments and noise makers, including whistles, hooters, horns, drums, and vuvuzelas. Specific conditions may apply for some events regarding the entry of musical instruments including drums.
- Confetti or shredded paper.
- Balloons or other inflatable items.
- Scooters, roller skates, skateboards, segways and push bikes.
- Electronic cigarettes (e-cig or e-cigarettes), personal vaporisers, electronic nicotine delivery systems, or other battery powered vaporisers are not permitted to be consumed anywhere in Perth Stadium.
- Hard Eskies and bags of larger dimensions that are unable to be stored under the seats. Eskys can be no larger than 30cm in width, 40cm in length & 30cm in height.
- Other items as determined by Perth Stadium f that may cause damage, harm or public nuisance.

*Please note the above Conditions of Entry may vary between events and reference should also be made to any Specific Conditions, Event Conditions and Ticket Conditions.*

### **Alcohol & Illegal Drugs**

Patrons and Ticket Holders entering Perth Stadium are advised that:

- Alcoholic beverages cannot be brought into or removed from Perth Stadium by Patrons or Ticket Holders. It is an offence to bring alcohol into this venue under the Liquor Control Act. Any breach of this Act may result in fines being applied.
- Intoxicated or drug affected Patrons and Ticket Holders will not be permitted to enter Perth Stadium, and if later found to be intoxicated or drug affected will be evicted.
- Patrons and Ticket Holders in possession of alcohol or illegal drugs will not be permitted to enter Perth Stadium, and if later found to be in possession of alcohol or illegal drugs will be evicted.
- Checking procedures will apply to prevent Patrons and Ticket Holders from entering Perth Stadium with alcohol or illegal drugs.

### **Dress Standards**

- Access to Premium Facilities, Bankwest Club, restaurants and dining room areas of Perth Stadium will be subject to dress codes with a higher minimum standard than required for general admission to Perth Stadium. As a guide, smart casual attire is the minimum standard required for the Premium Facilities, Bankwest Club, restaurants and dining areas.
- As a minimum for general admission, patrons must be appropriately clothed for a public place and must wear shoes. Patrons and Ticket Holders with bare feet will not be permitted entry to Perth Stadium.
