FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

KEY TIMINGS

- **WHAT ARE THE KEY TIMINGS?**

Event Commences – 4.00pm.

Event Concludes – 8.30pm.

TICKETING

- **DO I NEED TO BUY A TICKET?**

No, the Christmas Festival is a free event open to the general public, you are not required to purchase a ticket to attend this event.

- **CAN I LEAVE AND COME BACK?**

Yes. Patrons are permitted to come and go from the Christmas Festival as they please.

VENUE & EVENT INFORMATION

- **WILL MY BAG BE CHECKED?**

No. Security checks will not be carried out on bags.

- **WILL THE EVENT PROCEED WITH WET WEATHER?**

Yes. The event will proceed rain, hail or shine! This would only change if public safety becomes an issue.

- **WILL THERE BE FOOD AND DRINK AVAILABLE TO PURCHASE?**

Yes, a wide range of food and beverage facilities will be available throughout the site.

- **FOOD & BEVERAGE**

Optus Stadium is a fully licensed venue. Patrons are not permitted to bring their own alcohol.

A licenced bar will be available on the Southern Oval. Food trucks will be operational throughout the event site.

- **ARE CLOAKING FACILITIES AVAILABLE?**

Cloaking facilities will not be available.

- **WILL PRAMS BE PERMITTED INTO THE VENUE?**

Prams are permitted access to the venue for this event.

- **FIRST AID & MEDICAL ASSISTANCE**

Medical crews will be present in the Stadium Park to attend to any problems, no matter how big or small. Please see Stadium staff for assistance.

- **PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

The Perth Stadium Train Station is operational and will be running regular weekend services. Please use the [Journey Planner](#) to plan your travel arrangements.

- **PARKING**

Onsite parking is available for a small fee of \$5.00. Enter off Victoria Park Drive and follow the instructions of our friendly staff to secure a parking space.

- **ACROD PARKING**

ACROD parking will be available. Patrons are required display an ACROD permit to staff as they enter the stadium park precinct.

- **CAN WE GET DROPPED OFF AND PICKED UP?**

The designated location is Marlee Loop, however the Taxi Rank for drop offs and pickups using Taxi services.

- **IS THERE SHADE AVAILABLE?**

There is limited shade available on the event site. Large outdoor umbrella will be available in the licensed area on the Southern Oval. Please bring a hat and sunscreen.

- **WHAT YOU CANNOT BRING**

Strictly NO BYO alcohol. Security and Police will be onsite to enforce Liquor control laws. No glass items, tables or high back chairs are permitted.

- **DRESS STANDARDS**

Please wear footwear, and appropriate clothing for the event.

- **CAN I BRING MY DOG?**

Yes, pets and animals are permitted entry provided they are on a lead.

COVID-19 PREVENTION

- **WHAT MEASURES ARE IN PLACE TO KEEP US SAFE?**

The Optus Stadium Christmas Festival event site has been developed in conjunction with the WA Department of Health in the interests of reducing the potential risks associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. The following measures have been put in place in the interest of public safety.

- Event staff and messaging will be actively encouraging patrons to download the SafeWA app.
- Patrons will be able to utilise a QR Code installed at various points within the event site to register their attendance on the SafeWA app.
- Qualified and experienced COVID-19 marshals onsite throughout event.
- Social distancing encouraged at all food and retail vendors.
- Controlled capacity in licensed area and film screening to adhere to 1 person per 2 metres squared rule.
- Hand sanitiser freely available across event site.
- Regular visual and audio messaging throughout the event site stressing the importance of good hygiene practices and social distancing.

EVENT SPECIFIC

- **WHAT ENTERTAINMENT OPTIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE?**

The BHP Amphitheatre will host film screenings at 4:30pm and 6:30pm. Visit www.optusstadium.com.au for film listings. You can play garden games whilst catching up with friends in the licenced area or take part in art and craft activities and say hi to Santa. Roaming entertainers will make their way around the event site throughout the evening.

- **WHAT FOOD AND BEVERAGE OPTIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE**

There will be a wide array of food vendors with an eclectic collection of cuisine from right around the globe. A fully licensed bar serving alcoholic beverages will be available on the Southern Oval.

- **CAN I GET A PHOTO WITH SANTA?**

We can confirm that Santa has made time in his busy pre-Christmas schedule and will be making an appearance. To ensure the safety of all involved Santa will not be available for photographs and asks that everyone give him 1.5 metres of space as he makes his way around the event site.
